Visit to Cotswold Wildlife Park – Tuesday 14th March 2023

Our topic this half term is all about Kenya. We are concentrating on African animals and so on Tuesday 14th March, Elm will be visiting the Cotswold Wildlife Park in Burford. There will be a talk by one of the keepers about the African savannah ecosystem. The talk will mainly focus on the herbivores and carnivores in the Park.

We shall travel by coach, leaving school at 9.00 am and returning by the end of the school day.

The Park is all outdoors and **we will be going whatever the weather!** The children will need to wear school uniform, including a named waterproof coat and suitable footwear and to bring snacks and drinks with them. Please could you provide a rucksack for your child; one large enough to fit everything in, ensuring their hands are free at all times. Packed lunches will be provided for those children who would normally have a school lunch and those in receipt of pupil premium.

The cost of the trip is **£15**, which includes travel to and from the Park. *School will fund attendance for children who are registered for Free School Meals.* **The cost of this trip is being subsidised by the school.**

Parental donations towards the cost of trips are voluntary. No child will be denied participation in any trip if it takes place, but the school reserves the right to cancel planned events if too few contributions are received. If you have concerns about finance, please feel free to talk to Miss Wilson in confidence.
