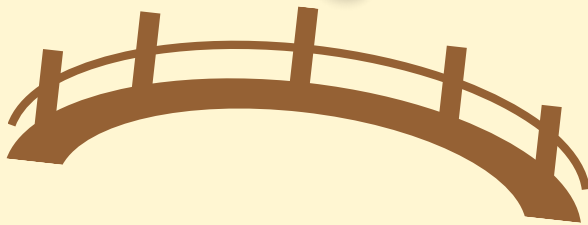


SEVERN TRENT
