Instead of recycling every glass jar, sturdy box, or tin right away, create a small “packaging pantry” in your home. These become your go to supply for gifting, organizing, or bulk shopping.

- Use pasta sauce jars for buying bulk nuts, rice, or spices.
- Repurpose boxes and padded envelopes for mailing or wrapping gifts.
- Offer extras to neighbors or local groups (people love free jars for crafts or storage).

It extends the lifecycle of packaging before recycling, which actually saves more energy and resources!
