## “Vegetable Graveyard” Broth Jar

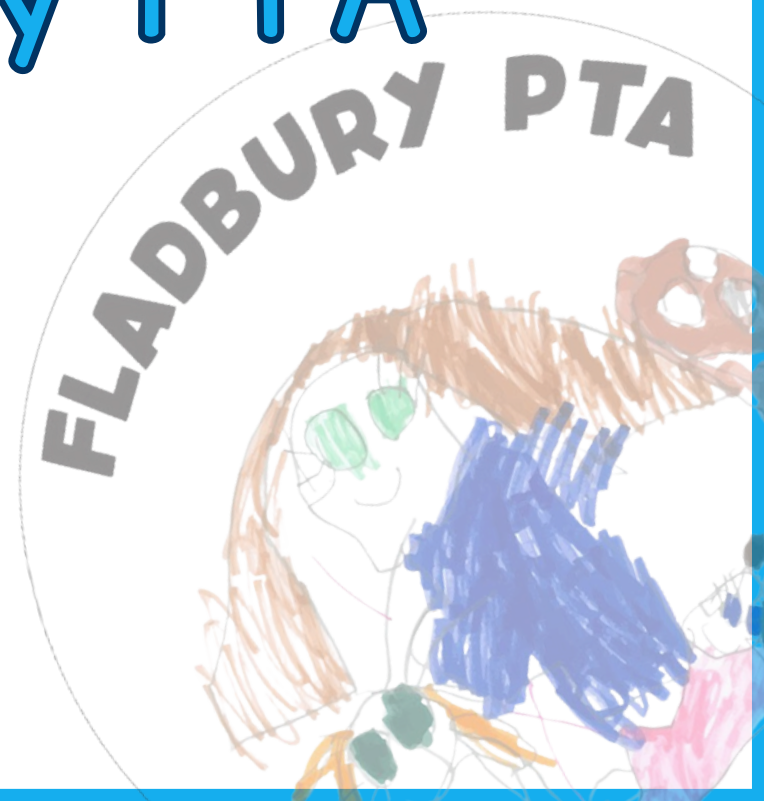
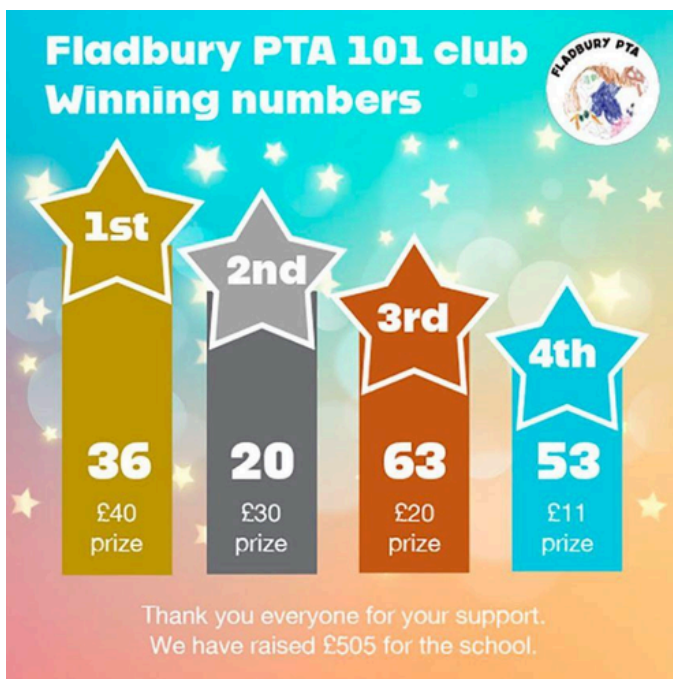
Instead of throwing out onion skins, garlic peels, carrot tops, mushroom stems or herb stalks... keep a sealed container in your freezer, your vegetable graveyard.

When it's full:

- Dump it into a pot, cover with water and simmer for an hour.
- Strain it – you've just made a rich, free vegetable broth.
- Compost what's left.

It's weirdly great because you're literally cooking rubbish into gold, it saves packaging, money and food waste and each batch tastes slightly different. A “mystery stock” that reflects your week's meals!
