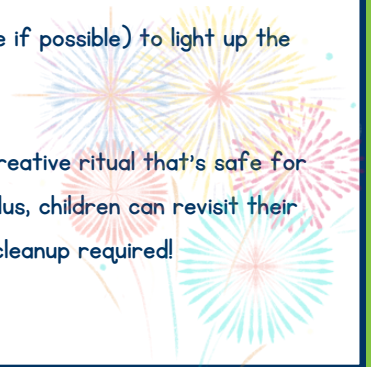


Make "Wish Jars" Instead of Fireworks!

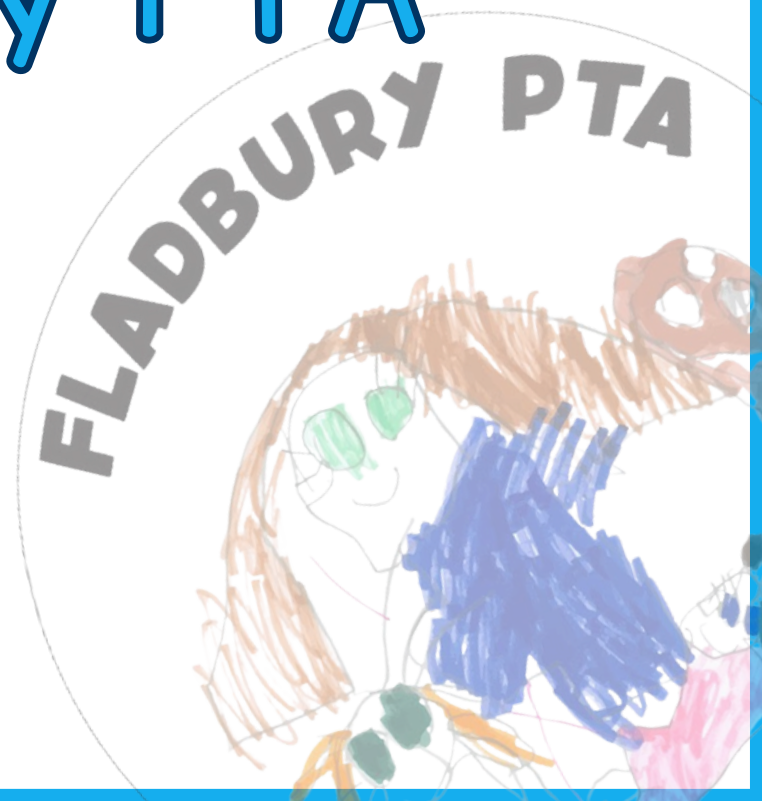
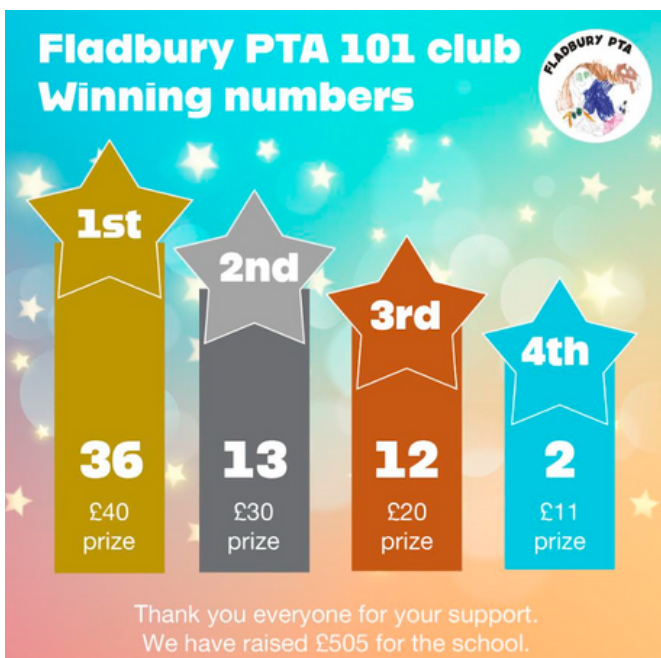

- Decorate a jar with recycled materials, glow-in-the-dark stickers or biodegradable glitter.
- Write wishes or dreams on small pieces of reused paper and place them inside.
- Add LED fairy lights or glow sticks (reusable if possible) to light up the jar at night.
