Create 'Cosy Zones' at Home

Pick one or two rooms where your family naturally gathers during winter evenings, and turn them into super-insulated cosy zones:

- Add extra blankets or throws
- Use draft stoppers or rolled towels under doors
- Hang a temporary curtain or tapestry over a doorway to trap warmth
- Place a warm-light lamp or LED string lights for atmosphere
- Keep hot cocoa supplies nearby for incentive

Then, intentionally lower the thermostat a degree or two house-wide.

It saves energy, feels festive and snug, and turns winter evenings into a cosy family ritual rather than a whole-house heat marathon!
