


The 'Layer Up' Challenge!


Instead of turning up the thermostat, have a 'layering contest'. Teach children the three-layer rule: a wicking base, an insulating middle (fleece/wool) and a waterproof outer.

Lowering your thermostat just 1°C can save roughly 6-8% on heating energy.
