The Lone Sock Rescue

Instead of throwing away socks that have lost their pair or have small holes, transform them into DIY Heat Packs or Puppets.

DIY Heat Packs - Fill a clean, lone sock with uncooked rice or dried beans and tie the end. Children can learn about reusable heat sources to stay warm instead of turning up the thermostat.

Sock Puppets - Use scrap fabric, old buttons and yarn to decorate. Children learn that they can create their own entertainment from waste rather than buying new plastic toys.

Textile waste is a major pollutant and by "rescuing" one sock, we are keeping rubbish out of landfills.

What to do if your child is too unwell to attend school:

What YOU must do:

- Telephone the school before 8.30am each day of your child's absence - you can leave a message using option 2.
- Tell the school in advance of any medical appointments and bring in appointment cards/letters.
- If you are not sure whether your child is well enough to attend school, send them in anyway as they often perk up on arrival or consult the following website:

- Have a backup plan for if your child misses transport, call on a family member, neighbour or friend.
- If you and your child are experiencing difficulties with school attendance then talk to us as a first step so we can help!

What WE will do:

- Check your child's attendance every day.
- Write or phone home to discuss your child's attendance with you.
- Invite you into school for attendance meetings if we are concerned.

If we cannot establish a reason for absence, then we may make a welfare home visit.

Don't forget to return the dietary and medical forms for Malvern Boundless Outdoors, as soon as possible.
