Food Waste Action Week 9th - 15th March

One thing you could do this week is start a Food Waste Diary. Track what gets thrown away and why (e.g., "didn't like the taste" or "forgot it was in the back") and at the end of the week, discuss how you can avoid those specific mistakes next time.

Wasting food isn't just about the food itself, it's about the "hidden" resources. Every time an apple is thrown away, we also waste the water used to grow it and the fuel used to drive it to the shop. In the UK alone, households throw away enough edible food to save the average family of four roughly £1,000 per year!
