September Routines and Arrangements

As we look ahead to the start of the new school year in September, we want to share the updated routines for drop-off, collection and key parts of the school day. These arrangements have been designed to support smooth transitions, clear routes for families, and a calm start for the children.

Drop-off and Collection - ALL doors will open at 08:45 and 15:25

- Reception and Preschool Children will be dropped off and collected from the old Preschool door. Staff will be ready to greet the children each morning and hand them over safely at the end of the day.
- Year 1 and Year 2 Children will use their new external classroom door, located next to the old Preschool door, for both drop-off and collection. This will help create a clear Early Years/KSI zone and support independence.
- Key Stage 2 (Years 3, 4, 5 and 6) Children will continue to be dropped off at the top door, as they do now. KS2 teachers will be at the door each morning to greet the children, ensuring a consistent and familiar start to the day.

Lunchtimes

We are delighted that, from September, all children will return to eating together in the school hall. Shared lunchtimes help build community, support social development and create a calm, structured dining experience.

Celebration Assembly

Our Friday Celebration Assembly will resume each week at around 09.05. Families have overwhelmingly told us they would like arrangements to continue as before, so we are very pleased to confirm that parents are warmly invited to join us in the school hall to celebrate children's achievements together.

Lockers for All Children

From September, all children will be allocated a personal locker, as we will no longer be using pegs. Year 5 have helpfully tested the locker size, and we can confirm that standard-sized backpacks fit comfortably. This change will help keep belongings organised and corridors clear.
